## Lake Forest Off-Leash Area Rules and Regulations

1. All dogs must be registered PRIOR to using Central Bark. Central Bark Tags will be issued at time of registration and must be worn by the dog(s) at all times within Central Bark. See below regarding registration information.
2. All owners MUST clean up after their dogs.
3. All dogs MUST be currently vaccinated in compliance with the Dallas City Code.
4. Dogs to remain on-leash while entering and exiting the designated area.
5. Any dog exhibiting aggressive behavior must be removed immediately.
6. All children under 12 years of age MUST be under adult supervision.
7. Female dogs in heat are NOT ALLOWED.
8. Owners shall repair any damage done by their dog (i.e. holes dug by the dog).
9. There are two designated areas – one for large and one for small dogs. Small dogs are considered 35lbs. and under.
10. All owners assume responsibility for any damage, disease, or injury to persons, other dogs, or property caused by their dog.
11. All owners use the off-leash area at their own risk.

### **What if I see someone not following the rules?**

*The Lake Forest off-leash area was established on the concept that dog owners would police themselves and each other. If you see someone who forgets the rules (i.e. forgets to pick up their dog's poop) politely introduce yourself, remind them of the rule, and thank them when they comply – or report any violations to Guardian at 972-458-2200. Lake Forest is full of friendly folks who want to do the right thing.*
